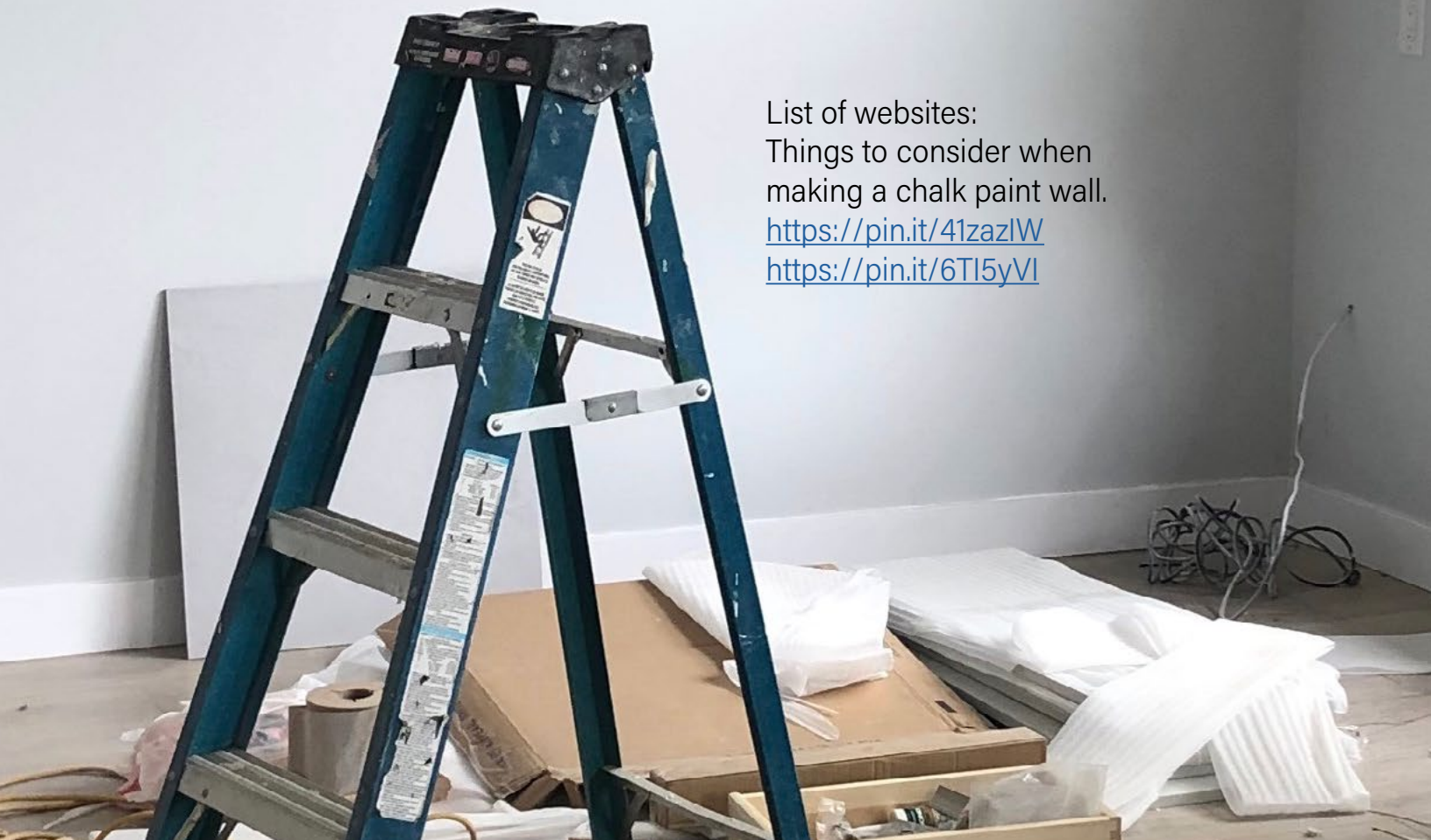

Tax Tips

It is that time of year again when we have to render to Caesar the things that are Caesar's and to God the things that are God's Mark 12:17

We are to bring the whole tithe into the storehouse Malachi 3:10. When we give a tenth of our earnings to the church where we are fed, then God not only multiplies the 90% we have left, but the government will allow a portion of our donations to be used as a non-refundable Federal and BC tax credits. This lessens the amount of taxes we must pay!

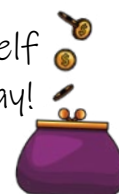
If you were born in 1955 or before you would be eligible to claim a maximum of \$7,637.00 on your Federal and a maximum of \$4,910.00 on your BC non-refundable tax credits!

If you are receiving a pension income, you can split the amount reported with your spouse and that will help with your not being in the next higher tax bracket! Then pay yourself second and open a RRSP and designate an amount you can put into your retirement plan annually. You will be surprised at how

your investment will grow and compound!

Open a TFSA and your savings will increase, and it will be tax free savings! If you have not applied for the BC Recovery Benefit, which is a one-time, tax-free payment of up to \$1,000 for eligible families and single parents, and up to \$500 for eligible individuals. You have until June 30, 2021 to apply.

Biblical Truth from Seed Germination

What does it take for a seed to sprout?

Have you ever wondered what happens to a seed before it sprouts? Take a look at the process of seed germination to learn this truth from God's creation.



Dormancy

Without a period of darkness, a seed will not germinate. Have you ever felt that you were in darkness and there was no future for you? Remember that the time of darkness is preparation for life and fruitfulness. Job 11:17 says "Life will be brighter than noonday, and darkness will become like morning." Take hope that your time of darkness is a precursor to a time of productivity and growth.

Imbibition

During this time of seed development, the seed takes in water and the tough seed coat softens and begins to split. Ephesians 5:26 says "washing with water through the word." In order for

us to grow, we need to absorb the Word of God and allow it to soften the hardness of our hearts.

Lag Period

There is a lag period before germination where the seed is using its stored food to begin metabolic processes in preparation for sprouting. During this time, genes are turned on so that the seed will be able to make the structures necessary for germination. Isaiah 62:10 says, "Prepare the way for the people. Build up the highway! Remove the stones. Raise a banner for the nations." What are you doing to prepare for your time of fruitfulness? Are you using this time of rest to get ready for God to move?

Radicle Formation

The radicle is the small root that emerges from the seed. It allows the seedling to be anchored in the soil and to absorb water and nutrients. Psalm 92:13 says "planted in the house of the Lord, they will flourish in the courts of our God." Are you planted in the house of God where you can receive the Word and be fed?

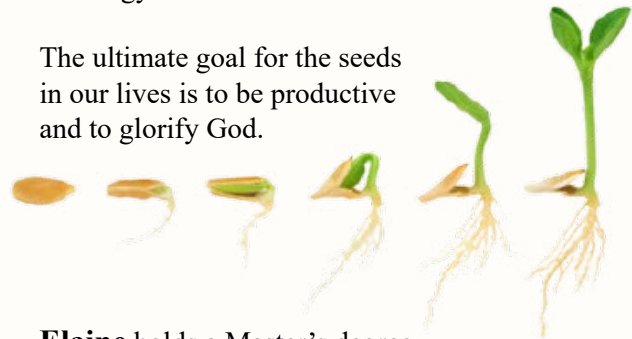
Leaf Emergence

Eventually, young leaves emerge from the soil. The leaves allow the seedling to use the sun's energy to make food for itself. Isaiah 60:21 says "They are the shoot I have planted, the work of my hands, for the display of My

splendor." Rejoice that you have been planted by God, the source of energy for all our endeavours.

The ultimate goal for the seeds in our lives is to be productive and to glorify God.

Instant Pot Pulled Pork

Preheat pot

Saute 2 inch cubed pork in 1-2 tbsp olive oil

Season with salt and pepper

Brown 3 minutes on each side and remove from the pot

Saute 3 cloves of smashed garlic

Add ½ cup chicken broth and scrape the pot to loosen the pork bits

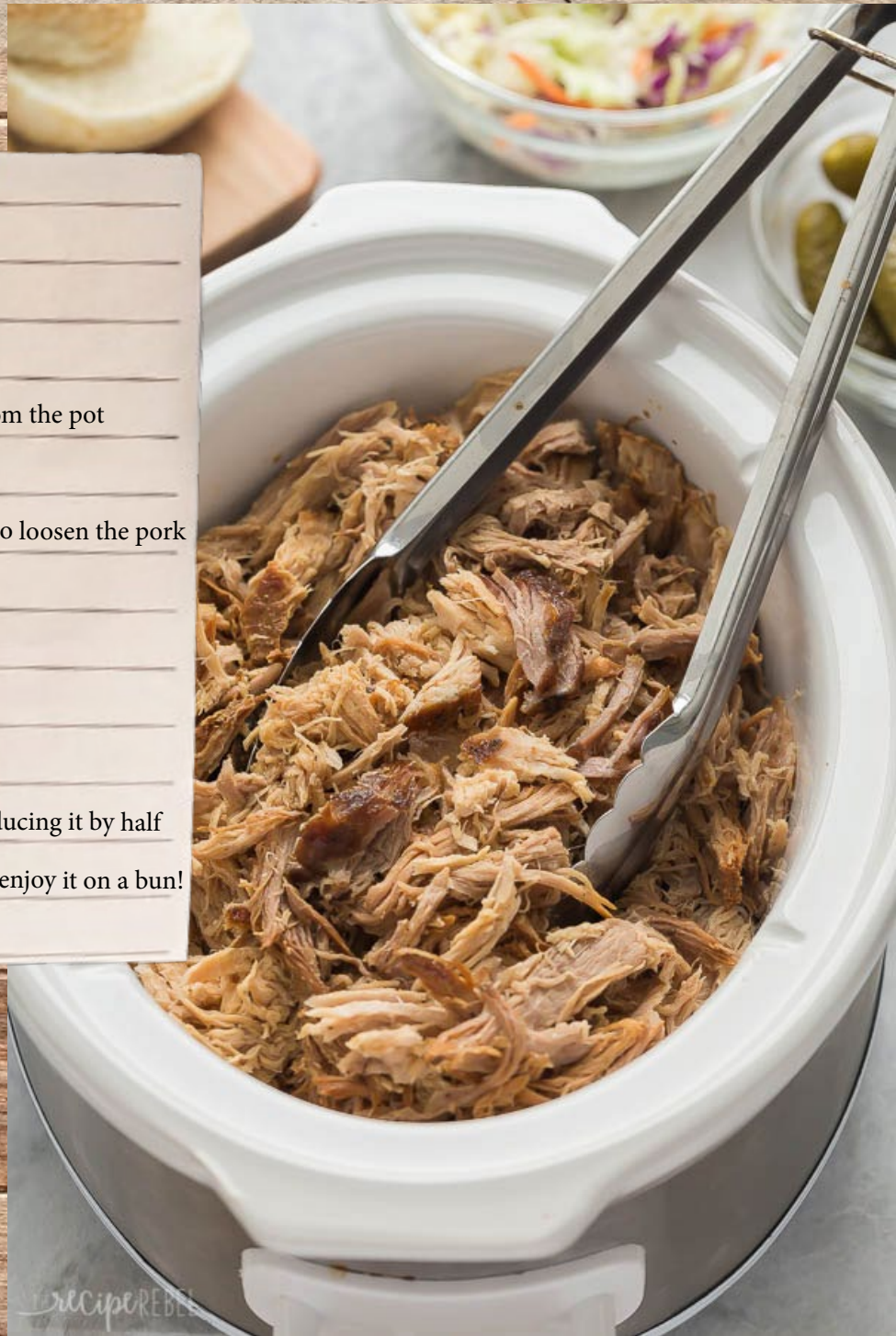
Add pork cubes in one layer

Add ½ jar of barbecue sauce

Pressure cook on high for 45 minutes

Remove the pork and thicken the sauce by reducing it by half

Pull the pork and moisten with the sauce and enjoy it on a bun!

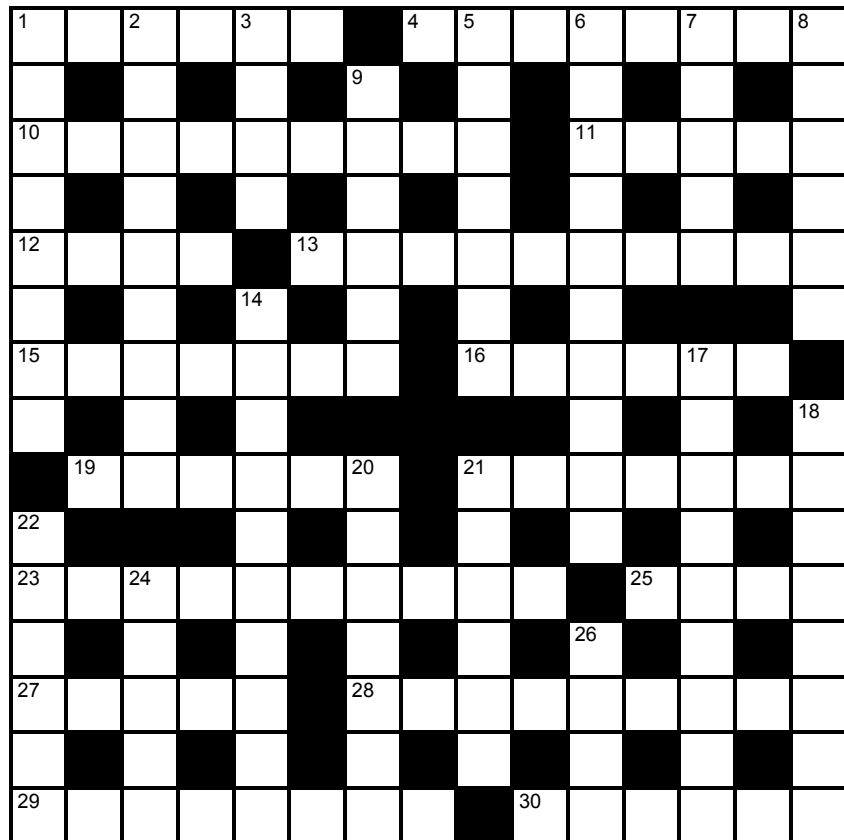
